The Pod was seated (seeded) at the Great Peppers meeting in September 2006.

The Pod's meetings are held in January, May and August.

The Pod voted to keep the same officers for 2007-2008.

Some of the Pod's under takings were to help Doris Reed to start the Blue Bonnet Teddy Bear Patrol in Texas. Help the Mitchell RV park with their Adell-Whitt VFD annual chili cookoff.

The Pod also does the tallying at TICC.

June 29 2008. Pepper Popper Bruce Stewart wrote up the Constitution and By-laws for the Pod. In August 2009, it was voted on, approved and signed by a Notary of the state of Texas.

May 11, 2009. Pepper Popper Bruce Stewart went to Jacksboro Texas county seat of Jack county and registered the BSOT Pod for Assumed name record for Banking and Tax purposes.

May 25, 2009. Elections were held to elect officers for 2009-2010.
