

# BBHS Roadrunners to compete in Abilene

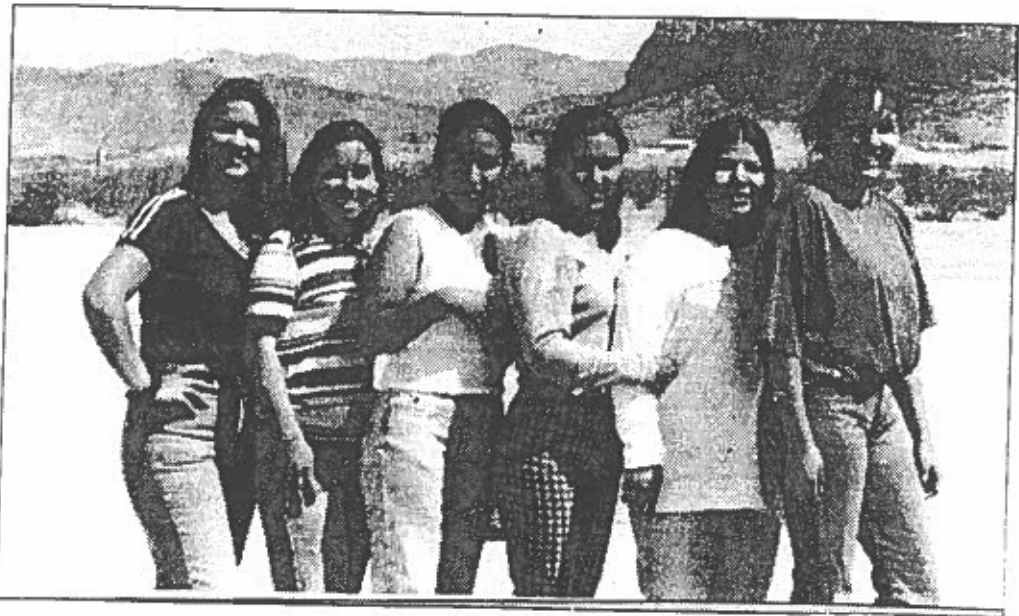
