Discussion was had on the Idaho State Championship. Vann made a motion that we accept the Idaho State Championship as the State Championship for Idaho. Ken Hudspeth seconded. Motion carried.

Discussion was had on how to handle a cook moving from a 12-point state to a state requiring fewer points. This needs to be handled on an individual basis. The responsibility for calling it to the attention of the Talleymaster should be on the cook. Points should be applied depending on where they are earned. The State Champion Title and runners up will depend upon residency when earned.

Larry Burruss has been in discussion with Glenn Pepper about improvements at Villa de la Mina. Glenn has plans to level additional areas.

Discussion was had on the Little Balkan Days cookoff in Nebraska and whether it should be afforded the status of a State Cookoff. On motion made and seconded, the Board voted to name it the State cookoff. It will be reviewed again next year.

Vann requested the Board members think about a permanent trophy. He will contact several foundries for prices.
