



Make No Mistake: Submit the correct cup count!

It is quite widely known that a minimum of fifteen cooks is required for CASI to sanction a cookoff. It should also be widely understood that those fifteen cooks must be on site cooking their chili and turn it in for judging. See CASI Rule V.A.5. This is also one of our rules that is strictly enforced. However, we occasionally see results sheets where the line for number of chilis judged, is a number less than fifteen. Make no mistake, that line must show a number of fifteen or greater. If there is a number less than

fifteen, the TallyMaster cannot accept the results and must determine the reason for a less than fifteen report. Usually the reason is that a cup (or more) was disqualified prior to going to the

judging table, thus the lower number. It is important to note that Rule V.A.5 states that at least fifteen cups must be "turned in" for judging. I suppose we could change the line to read, "Number of chilis turned-in," but until that happens, understanding of the rule is necessary. In

of the rule is necessary. In Rule V.A.5 you will also see that the minimum number of chilis for Regional, National, and International Open championships is twenty-five.

Years ago, about the time my involvement with CASI began, the minimum number for all cookoffs was twenty-five. Lowering that number from twenty-five to fifteen enabled CASI to expand to many other states where chili was not a major part of the culture, where twentyfive cooks would be nearly impossible. That was a major part of CASI's growth.

Over the years additional


minimum number requirements were added for the purpose of allocating automatic qualifications. In Rule VII.E.1d we find that State Opens, including Men's and Women's may qualify an additional two resident cooks if they have a minimum of 150 chilis

turned in. For Regional, National, International Opens, that number adds two automatic qualifications regardless of residency. While the language in Rule VII.E.1d is a little different from V.A.5, the intent is the same; that minimum number must be present and the cups turned in for judging.

Rule VII.E.1h adds minimum cook numbers that would give an automatic qualification to the first place winner of otherwise non-automatic qualifying cookoffs. And once again the language does not align with Rule V.A.5, but the intent remains the same.

So, make no mistake, when submitting paperwork to CASI, make sure the number of chilis judged line reflects the actual number of cups turned in for judging, including any disqualifications.
