50th Annual Howdy-Roo To Honor It's Founders



1972: The Highland Lakes Tourist Association urged all the area Chamber of Commerce's to have an event to promote tourism.

That is when Aqua Boom in Kingsland, Spring Ho in Lampasas, the Burnet Fiddler's Fest and Howdy-Roo all got started. Clyde Griffin held the first meeting of the Marble Falls group. and it was decided to have an old fashioned country festival and a chili cookoff. There was a "Name that Festival" contest held which was won by Bill Kennon. He was therefore given the honor of being the first Honchoroo of Howdy-Roo, the name he submitted. His was the only entry, but it was a good one, and a lasting one.

Bill Wilcox (Clements-Wilcox Funeral Homes of Burnet and Marble Falls) had attended a chili cookoff, therefore had some expertise, and helped organize the first Howdy-Roo. From that beginning Bill has sponsored one of the granite trophies. The chili cooks treasure the granite, State of Texas trophies.

The first Howdy-Roo chili cookoff was held on April 8, 1972, on the school grounds (currently the elementary school). There were twenty cooks at this first cookoff. Mary Griffin of Marble Falls and Gary Hahne tied. Because of this tie they awarded a men's and women's division. This was done for three years.

The Highland Lakes Pod (HLP)

was founded in 1977 by Clyde and Mary Griffin of Marble Falls and Darrell Staedtler of Llano. Clyde and Darrell were co-Great Peppers of the pod. They

received a letter inviting them to the first Great Peppers meeting held on September 6, 1980 at Paul Smith's Sky-High Ranch near Weatherford. Clyde and Mary attended, representing the Highland Lakes Pod. The pod filed to be incorporated September 8, 1982. The official Articles of Incorporation are dated February, 1983. The Registered Agent was Clyde O. Griffin. At this time the members voted to have The Supreme Great Pepper be Clyde Griffin. No other Great Pepper shall have such designation in the pod.

In 1986 the World's Biggest Pot of Chili was part of the Texas state

wide Sesquicentennial celebration in San Antonio. HLP members Clyde and Mary Griffin, Ruby Ross, Sharon Roy and Red Caldwell, along with many other chili heads were called upon to

help turn 4,000 pounds of meat into the largest pot of chili in the world.

In 1988 R.V. Turney, who was GP that year, presented the winner with an apron. This apron is still passed on the new winner each year.

In 1990 it was decided the chili cookoff and chamber would have

separate events. Highland Lakes Pod continued to sponsor the Howdy-Roo Chili Cookoff the first weekend in May. The Highland Lakes Pod made application for the Howdy-Roo Trademark and Tradename. Howdy-Roo is owned by HLP.

In 1996 HLP began having Howdy-Roo on Saturday and the Backbone Cook-off on Sunday. In 2011 Howdy-Roo was granted the CASI Regional CCO with an automatic sanction for the top three winners. BBQ and beans were added also this year.

and Texas Men's State - with Texas Ladies State and Howdy-Roo on the horizon.

A recent weekend in Texas found five cookoffs within a 100-150 mile radius. While cooks had several to choose from, it also diluted the attendance at some of the cookoffs.

I'm always fascinated to hear stories of how folks began this hobby of cooking chili. In late 1983 in my other life, we were trying to find something to do to occupy our weekends. We heard about Czhilispiel in Flatonia and decided to attend - but not participants. The first thing we noticed were the showmanship teams and how much fun they seemed to be having, not to mention the crowd response.

We also realized the lack of showmanship that appealed to children, of which there were many in attendance. My first show consisted of dressing as clowns, in full makeup, doing face painting and providing games for children to play.

While we qualified for Terlingua in 1984, I failed to get my first chili point for many months. And that was all right. The sheer joy from attending cookoffs and meeting so many wonderful people was all worth it. My chili family is now, and will always be, near and dear to my heart.

I miss the days of Great Southwest Show Team, Tex Swindle's Medicine Show, Tejas Medicineman, Planet Texas - the list goes on and on. Those were the days of big shows along the lines of variety shows.

It's sad to see some cookoffs not having three show teams competing. I have to wonder if this is also contributing to the lack of public attending. How many times have we said "who wants to come watch a group of people stirring chili pots"?

Let's start a conversation about how we can revive interest in showmanship. Yes, it's a lot of work and can be costly, but the rewards are great. If you have ideas or suggestions, please let me know. Call, email, text, Facebook or approach me at a Cookoff - I'd love to hear from you.

Stay safe out there, get those points, and I hope to see you on the chili trail soon!

Make No Mistake: CASI Cook-off Listing Info Is Key

When you see a cook-off listing in the Terlingua Trails or on the CASI website, you should expect the information contained in that listing to be accurate. Rightfully so. Occasionally, a person other than the person who listed the event, will produce the cook-off promotional material, sometimes months later. But what happens when the two parties get their signals crossed, and information differs between the CASI listing and the printed material?

If the discrepancy is caught in time, one of the sources can be changed thus preventing

any problem; and I would not have material for this article. So I will consider three areas where the information disagrees and it is too late to correct the published materials.

If the entry fee shown on the printed flier is lower than the CASI listing, there should

not be much of an issue. You could defer to the CASI listing

But what happens when the two parties get their signals crossed, and information differs between the CASI listing and the printed material?

and charge the higher fee, or go with the lower fee and reimburse anyone who pre-registered at the higher fee. However, if the amount shown on the printed flier is higher than the CASI listing, some cooks might object to being charged more than they expected. They could point to the CASI listing and demand the lower entry fee, and I would agree with them. Cooks are customers and they are always right.

If the meat type given on

the cookoff flier disagrees with what the CASI listing says, that is more problematic. For example, if the CASI listing indicates the open meat category, but your flier says ground meat only, a cook showing up with cut meat could be real upset if not allowed to cook. You would

> have a very unhappy cook and a possible protest. You don't want either.


The chili turn-in time listed in the CASI cook-off listing is rather inflexible. Cooks plan their schedule around that

time. If there is discrepancy between the information sources, the CASI listing should take precedence. If a later time was desired, and all the cooks agreed to that, it would be acceptable. However, moving the time up, without prior notification, could cause a cook to miss the necessary time to cook. Like the previous example, this could result in trouble you don't want.

So, make no mistake, the information contained in the CASI cookoff listing is the default information. Let's keep our ducks in a row and have a great spring and summer season.







Trails Advertising Update






