When a cook-off is cancelled, the Events Coordinator must be notified in order to keep the website current.


At that time, I had never heard of CASI and had no idea there were competitive cook-offs. So, off to the



# Make No Mistake: Officials' Membership Maintenance

Not very long ago I was asked a question with regards to the requirement of pod officers and referees to maintain their CASI membership during the current chili year. This is found in Article XIV, Section 3 of the CASI Bylaws. The question and subsequent discussion centered on the phrase, "...membership must be maintained throughout the entire Chili Year in which they will be serving..."

We are getting into the season when pod credentials are submitted and membership status verified, so the question was timely.

Pod officers and referees, along with CASI Directors and off-board support staff, are considered CASI officials. It is only natural to expect officials of an organization, to be members of that organization, so it was written into CASI Bylaws. Back when that requirement came to be, CASI membership was for the period October 1 to September 30, so you either were a member or you were not.

When CASI changed the membership period to an anniversary based system, it created an issue for certain individuals. Not at first, since just about everyone was still on the chili year system. Eventually, as new people with anniversary date memberships began to take leadership positions, the issue grew.

The CASI Executive Director was in charge of the pod officers and referees at the time and was having trouble with people who were members on October 1, but had their membership expire before the end of the chili year. Consequently, the bylaws were amended to add the, "throughout the year" stipulation.

My questioner reasoned that a member who renews their membership prior to the expiration date is maintaining their membership, and to a certain extent, that is true. However, we no longer have a mechanism to check for delinquent renewals, and we did not want to be shifting names on and off and on again the lists of referees and officers. The solution was to require that membership be for the entire year on day one.

I took over the verification of referees' membership in 2015. Since that time, I have worked with several Membership Directors and individuals, and we have gotten quite a few of them to the September 30 expiration date.


Make no mistake, if you will be a pod officer or referee in the 2023 chili year, your CASI membership must be paid up through at least September 30, 2023.




