

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From the CASI President...

With a recent cool front coming through, it feels more like fall and makes preparing for the trip to the desert a little easier. My garage is slowly filling with tubs and boxes in preparation for loading and heading west.

I made a trip to the Marathon/Study Butte/ Terlingua/Lajitas areas a couple of weeks ago to deliver merchandise to the Ranch and visit with local businesses. Our TICC poster now graces the walls of the majority of the stores and restaurants. While there, I took the opportunity to invite folks out to not only judge, but also participate, in the many competitions.

The number of tourists in the area was overwhelming and I'm sure the economy in the area is at an all time high. The outfitters in the area are staying busy and accommodations are scarce.

The weather is forecast to be great for Cook-off week. It will be great to see so many who I only see once a year. Many are

unable to make it for various reasons and you will be missed. Sadly, we have also lost many of our chili cooks this year. They will be honored at the Thursday Memorial Board service.

There have been ongoing questions regarding the facility usage fee. This is not a gate fee nor an entrance fee – this is to assist with the rising costs of doing business. For example, the garbage contract this year is approximately \$6,000



and portalets run \$17,800.00; our insurance costs have also risen to almost \$26,000. The fee assessed per cook at cook-offs last year raised \$16,000, which leaves us with a deficit for insurance of \$10,000. This is part of the "why" of the facility usage fee.

I hope all have a safe trip to TICC and down the chili trail!



Chili Year 2022–2023

As your new board member and TallyMaster, I wish you all the best of luck for the 2022-2023 chili year! Not a lot has changed since serving as your Assistant TallyMaster in years past. Brian and I will be working together to ensure the transition will be smooth and swift.

I would love to see your cook-off results submitted as soon as possible using our online system, and in return, I will process them

as quickly as I get them. Please remember, 1st place through 10th place qualifiers are derived by the top ten winners at TICC. Once TICC is recorded, I will process the auto-qualifiers, and maybe even a lucky qualifier or two, from all results received from October 1st to the present, in the order in which they were received.

Please feel free to contact me with any questions you might have regarding the online entry of your cookoff results. I would like to see everyone taking advantage of this useful tool. It saves time and postage for everyone.

I hope to see you at TICC and hope that you will come by Registration and lend a hand. It's always fun at Registration because EVERYONE will come to see YOU! Please check out SignUpGenius and find a time that will work for you! Please bring your legal photo I.D. when you come to registration, this is a requirement for everyone!

The required paperwork to send to the TallyMaster is as easy as 1-2-3:

- 1. A **COMPLETED** results page. All information must be filled in, for example, the date, cook-off number, and name of the cook-off, as well as, each cook's address, must be complete. Do not forget the referee's signature at the bottom of the results page.
- The registered cooks and show pages. Please make sure all cooks and show entrants fill out their information in its entirety.
- The check or an online payment made for the cook-off. I am automatically notified of PayPal payments.

You may scan all pages together in one file or separately, I will get them either way. Any other tally work done at the cookoff is for your records, and in some cases your regional referee (if indicated.) Please do not send or scan these papers to me.

Make No Mistake: Merch Okay-But No Cash Prizes

Make no mistake, cash prizes for winning chili or showmanship are not allowed. CASI Rules (V.B.2) are quite clear on this. I have written about this subject previously, but we have new people (a good thing) and the question comes

up occasionally.

Because the subject of merchandise prizes is not covered in the rules, this is where the questions often arise. Over the years the Rules Committee has had several opportunities to examine the subject of merchandise for prizes. Often a sponsor may want to donate an item from their business to the cook-off. This is an acceptable prize. Gift cards are also an acceptable prize, right now a gas card would be really helpful. What is not acceptable is a bank card that can be redeemed for cash.

Another idea that was discussed, and found to be illegal was the idea of the cookoff adding money to the cooks' pot. That was found to be the same thing as giving a cash prize. In fact, when the cookoff promoter gets involved in the cooks' pot it is pretty much the same thing as giving a cash prize, plus it takes money away from the charity. This scenario is discouraged by the Rules Committee.

Major open championships (regional, national, international, and state) may award cash as travel expense money for their qualifiers to attend TICC. This benefits CASI if it encourages a cook to compete at TICC. However, make no mistake, that money may only be used to cover travel expenses to Terlingua.

I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate our new TICC Champion. We do not know who that is yet, but I'm sure they will be deserving and thrilled as hell!



I made a few changes to the Trails


