
Terlingua Trails Memorial Wall Service


SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM REPORT



Make No Mistake: Keeping Cooks' Pot Legal

Well kids, I guess it is time we had "The Talk" about cooks' pots. Make no mistake, the cooks' pot is a friendly wager between the cooks at any given cook-off. CASI has no rules governing cooks' pots because CASI does not have, or want, anything to do with them. *They are by the cooks for the cooks.* This concept works quite well. But when the cook-off promoter (individual, charity, or pod) gets involved, problems can occur. When the cook-off collects money for the cooks' pot and pays the winner(s) they are, in effect, paying cash prizes. This is a violation of CASI Rule V.B.2. Even if the money for the cooks' pot is kept separate from the entry fee money, the perception is there. Also, if the cook is permitted to include the cooks' pot money on his entry fee check, it is not separate. In that scenario the cookoff is in violation of CASI Rules when they pay the cooks' pot winner.

The pivot. Collecting cooks' pot money at registration is a convenient method to do it. In certain parts of the country it is a very common practice, and I am not aware of any problems caused by this practice. So, does the convenience justify violating CASI Rules? The important thing is to keep the cooks' pot money separate from the cook-off entry fee money, and I do see a workable solution. A person (preferably a cook), not associated with running the cookoff, can collect the cooks' pot money at registration. Thus, keeping it separate. But, make no mistake, including the cooks' pot money on the same check as the cook-off entry fee, is not right.

The swivel. While in Terlingua, I had a chat with an old friend about CASI Rules. He suggested that some of our rules might be too restrictive to attract the next generation of cooks necessary for CASI to survive and thrive. To a certain extent, I had to agree with him. However, I had to remind him that I do not make the rules. That is the Great Peppers' job. My job is to help the referees apply the rules to cook-off situations. My job is to help the Rules Committee apply the rules to possible rules violations. The purpose of this column has been to help people understand the rules so we don't have infractions.

However, I offered to open up my space to him and anyone else as a forum on rules that might be getting in the way of CASI moving forward. We have over a year and a half before rules changes must be submitted for the 2024 Great Peppers' Meeting. Let's see if we can examine some rules that might deserve consideration for change. 


