VASA Pod Celebrates 41st Pod Cook-off

The judges had such fun during the margarita judging! There was much laughter and not much margarita left when the judging was done. We all knew she would be a force to be reckoned with when she started cooking in the adult division, as she was nearly unbeatable when cooking in the Junior division. This was Amber's first auto-Q win and she was extremely excited, as were her parents. As a college student she doesn't get a lot of opportunities to cook, so now she's guaranteed an invitation to 2023 TICC. ☺

Of course the last day of competition, Sunday, the weather was warm and sunny, with only a

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



Happy 2023! With the New Year comes new resolutions. Have you made one? Why not take care of yourself with a little upkeep of your records?


May I suggest a resolution for you? How about logging into the "Members Only" portion of the www.casichili.net

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Make No Mistake: Membership, Dues and TICC

I hope everyone had a great holiday season. Now it is time to get to work leading to TICC #56 this November. I hope to see an increase in cooks, shows and spectators this year.

Last month I offered to examine some of our rules

that may be restricting the participation of cooks and show teams. And you are invited to comment. The first one of the rules to examine is VII.E.1j, which states:

"To cook at TICC, a cook must be a paid CASI member. A "member" is one who has paid annual dues for the current year or has become a life member of CASI. Paid status is determined by a deadline of September 30th of each chili year, immediately prior to TICC, for which the cook has qualified with a 10-day grace period."

This rule actually has two parts, and is repeated for show team captains in Rule VII.E.2b. The rule was originally adopted in 1996 because, basically, we did not want anyone on stage

accepting that big pepper who was not a CASI member. The rule was expanded in 2003 to include show team captains. I do not believe that is an unreasonable expectation, or restrictive. Do you agree, or disagree?

The second part of the rule, requiring membership by September 30, with a 10-day grace period (Couldn't it have just said October 10th?) was added in 2014. The justification for this change was, "To ease the burden on the TallyMaster and volunteers at TICC." Burden? Make no mistake, when collecting membership dues becomes a burden, it is time to eliminate dues. I have had some experience with

TICC registration, and paying dues was part of the job. This rule really seems to fit in the restrictive arena. There could be numerous reasons a person could run afoul of this rule, and I would hate to see it prevent someone from participating in TICC. I do welcome your comments on this.




