



Make No Mistake: No ID, No Judging Cup?

There are many "rules" in CASI that are a result of a singular incident or occurrence. Some of these "rules" aren't even official rules–they are just policies. This month I will discuss one of these "policies."

Back in 2004 at the "other" Terlingua cook-off, an incident

occurred that we on the CASI side would not want happening at TICC. A non-qualified cook obtained a judging cup by identifying himself as his brother who was qualified to cook-but had not come to Terlingua. At turn-in time, the non-qualified cook got several chili samples from nearby (and unwitting) cooks, which he used to fill his cup. He then proceeded to turn this blended chili in. This incidence of cheating might have gone quietly into the night, but his cup happened to win first *place!* Later that afternoon, the cheater was convinced to come clean and the correct winner was identified, but the damage had already been done. To make matters worse, the perpetrator

was from my home state of Illinois. I was determined that this mistake would not happen at TICC.

In 2005, we started requiring a photo ID to receive a chili judging cup and/or receive a team number to perform in showmanship. The problem is that this procedure was devised by the head show judge and myself. It was not a CASI Rule, nor was it a Board Policy. It has just been there. During the intervening years, there have been opportunities to look at this and it still remains in effect.

On one occasion, the Rules Committee was asked to look at this requirement, but since it was not a rule we declined. Cooks have adapted to this requirement, that is, until they get to registration without their ID and still want their cup! The person that caused this requirement to become necessary passed away a few years ago.

Make no mistake, we will not allow cheating at TICC, so now may be a good time to look at this. Consequently, I have asked the CASI Board to review this subject and either do away with it, or officially make it a CASI Policy.

While they are at it, they could look at the requirement of showing a photo ID to get a wrist band, too. Since everyone pays now, what is the point? There is no sneaking-in.






