Fire at Terlingua CSD campus claims robotics and band building

CASI and community rally to support the students and school

Editors Note: This story appeared February 22 in the Big Bend Sentinel online edition, by Sam Karas. TERLINGUA — Just after midnight last Friday morning (2/16), a fire broke out at the Terlingua CSD campus. By the time the sun came up, the tiny school district's band and robotics building was rendered a total the blaze from the outside loss — as well as the personal belongings and equipment of the students in both programs.

Dispatch was alerted at 1:51 a.m. Terlingua Fire and EMS, the Brewster County Sheriff's Department, and National Park Service fire crews responded quickly and helped prevent the blaze from also claiming the school library.

Former Terlingua CSD teacher Nate Simons called 911, initially assuming that the blaze on the horizon was an out-of-control burn pile. In addition to contacting dispatch, he called Superintendent Reagan Reed at home to start alerting school leadership.

While waiting for the pros to show up. Simons rushed to the scene as the first first responder. Armed with fire extinguishers from home, he did his best to contain

— noting that the fire had already started to destabilize the building from below. "It was purely a neighborly thing," he said of his splitsecond decision to assist.

Simons stayed with the fire crews until around 3 a.m., and Superintendent Reed stayed through sunrise. As students and staff started waking up and getting ready for school, news gradually spread through the community about what had happened overnight.

Junior Gigi Keenan found out about the fire from her dad. She thought he was running late to pick her up for school, so she gave him a

call — and he told her the bad news. He'd just received word that school was canceled because of a fire that had broken out at the band and robotics building. "It was devastating," Keenan said.

Some of Keenan's classmates had big ticket items go missing — a guitarist lost a series of amps and the percussionists lost two drum sets and a keyboard. Director Bradley Anthenat who also serves as the school's robotics coach and IT specialist — lost a trombone he'd had since childhood.

The fire also claimed "Big Girl," a robot that the robotics students would have used for a regional competition in Lubbock. "The robotics parts, playing field and tools will all be replaced, but the students' and [Coach]



Make No Mistake: Time to Get Growing

We started this year by looking at rules (CASI Rules) that appear restrictive to the point they do not allow CASI to survive and thrive. The rules dictating the number of cooks at a cook-off would seem to fall into that category.

First, a little history. The original CASI Rules published some forty years ago required a minimum of 25 cooks for any cook-off. That may have seemed like an appropriate number at the time, but it did result in a low number of cook-offs (and I'm sure they were good events).

By the mid-eighties, an effort was made to attract new cook-offs and cooks. The rules at that time based the minimum number of cooks required on the states' point requirement: A twelve-point state required 25 cooks, a nine-point state required 20 cooks, and a six-point state required 15 cooks. However, all open championships still required 25 cooks as a minimum.

In the early nineties, the current cook requirement was adopted. All regular cook-offs, including state championships, only require a minimum of 15 cooks. Regional and international open championships still required 25 cooks.

During the end of the Twentieth Century and the beginning of the Twenty-first Century, CASI, and TICC, experienced phenomenal growth. There were other contributing factors, for sure, but the relaxed cook-off sanctioning requirements had to play a major role in this growth. That growth has slowed to a crawl. So, make no mistake, something must be done to inspire more cook-offs, producing more cooks and CASI members.

The answer is more than likely complicated, so we have to start the conversation now. I am going to offer some possible changes that may or may not work. You may have some ideas as well; let's hear them. We have a year and a half before the next Great Peppers' Meeting. Surely we can come up with something.

The simplest solution (and yes, it has been rejected in the past) would be to lower the number of cooks required to say 12 or 10. Obviously, this would dilute the value of points awarded. Currently, at the minimum we award points to ²/₃ of the cooks, so I would propose to use that as the maximum number of cooks to get points. A cook-off with 12 cooks would only award points to the top eight cooks, and would start with eighth place and the cooks just getting one point up to second, which would get two points.


A state championship would lose automatic qualifications if they fall below the fifteen-cook level. The particulars could be worked out if that concept becomes reality.

Regional and international open championships could also benefit from a relaxed cook requirement. I have seen open championships reduced to regular point cookoffs because they failed to meet the minimum number of cooks required. A scale of automatic qualifications could easily be determined.
