For cook-offs that have more than 6 showmanship entries, the showmanship period will last 2 hours during the Cook-off.

Just wanted to get that out there for the benefit of the hard working showmanship participants. The rules goes on to state if adverse conditions occur how it is to be handled.

I hope you are all having a successful Chili year and getting those points to compete at TICC this year. The CASI Board is busy planning the event and welcomes any suggestions. Our summer Board Meeting will be in Amarillo on July 8 and we welcome anyone who wishes to attend.





request. These posters may be used as a guideline for some of the content required in the design.



If selected, artwork becomes the sole property of the Chili Appreciation Society International, Inc. The winning designer will receive credit with their name included on the final product.


If selected, artist agrees to sign and number fifty prints within 30 days of request.

Make No Mistake: Revisit the CASI Regionals Rules

Last month I coughed up an idea to make the Tuesday at TICC cook-off an automatic qualifier at the Regional level. While such an event could add people to TICC week, and be great for local cooks, it would not add cooks to that current TICC. The qualification would be for the following year. But, make no mistake, it is worth investigating.

Occasionally, over the last couple decades, the proposal for a "last chance" cook-off have surfaced. When I was TallyMaster, I opposed the idea because the software we used then would have made adding those late qualifiers

very difficult. However, the advances in technology have made that point moot. Other people opposed the idea because they felt that cooks had all year to qualify, and they had not done so by TICC, too bad. Once again, times have changed and the opportunities for points are down. Make no mistake, an event such as that would certainly add cooks to the current TICC. For that reason alone, it is definitely worth considering.


Here are some ideas to consider: There are a couple ways to set this cook-off up. One would be as an automatic qualifier for the top three or five, or whatever number is appropriate. Another way would be to award points as a normal cook-off. What do you think?

It has been suggested that perhaps our pod requirements for regional and international championships are too restrictive. Perhaps it is. A regional open requires two sponsoring pods in the region. The decreasing number of pods makes this requirement more challenging. The decreasing number of cookoffs throughout CASI make the fifteen cook-off in a region, also more challenging. It might be a good time to review the rules with regard to holding a CASI Regional Open Championship. The current rules are fifteen years old; from a year that saw 562 sanctioned cook-offs.

The folding of a pod triggered the demise of an international open. We are down to one. Keep in mind that a CASI Pod is vital in the support of these regionals. They supply the head judge and referee, plus promote the cook-off to the local cooks. So, while this requirement for opens may be restrictive, it appears to be necessary. *Bill Pierson*




